Departure of participants

Control of the Nations

The control of the delegations will be on Friday 01 October 2010 from 10:00 to 18:00 at Airport Palace Hotel; after this time the delegations will not be registered for the draw.

Competition mode:

Tournament will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF/EJU, the competition system KO with **quarterfinal** (last 8) **repechage**. Seeding of the top 8 among entered competitors according to the World Ranking List, Rest of the draw – separation by nations.

Preliminaries 3 mats (8 m x 8 m)
Fights for 3rd places 2 mats (8 m x 8 m)
Finals 1 mat (8 m x 8 m)

Number of Participants

According to IJF/EJU rules, maximum number of participants will be:
Each country: 4 competitors per weight category
Organizing country: 4 competitors per weight category



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Doping controls

The gold medal winner and another drawn medallist of each weight category have to submit, after the finals, to the doping control.

Referees

Each participating National Federation must be accompanied by one IJF “A” or “B” Referee. This is a condition for the participation at this tournament, according to the requirements of EJU rules for World Cups and to secure neutral refereeing. Maximum number of referees will be:

Each country: 1 referee
Organizing nation: 4 referees
Referees meeting: Friday 01 Oct. 2010 - 19:00 – Airport Palace Hotel

Entries

- a) **First entry: before 02 August 2010** to the Italian Judo Federation
- b) **Hotel Reservation before 04 September 2010** to the Italian Judo Federation
- c) **Final entry: before 20 September 2010** to the Italian Judo Federation + to the EJU through JUMAS System -see details on www.europejudo.com

Judogis

Blue and white judogis will be obligatory.

There will be judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule approved by the IJF on 01st January 2009.

All competitors are obliged to have back numbers on their judogis

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.

2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

3. The organizer will deliver the CHANGEABLE part during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.





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Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket).
Maximum size 100 cm².
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down sleeve - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm in national colours or manufacturer's logo of official supplier. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's logo (on bottom front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trousers and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU approved" Logo above their logo (adjacent) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's logo on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket (max 20 cm²)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These areas must be fixed just below and in contact with the shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The name of the contestant may be printed or stitched on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.
