€60 per team (payment by check or via HelloAsso)

3. TEAM COMPOSITION CRITERIA

✓ Judokas must belong to the same region.

Teams may combine members from different committees, clubs, or friends as long as they come from the same region.

Age groupings:

• TMF -45: M1 to M3 / F1 to F3

• TMF -60: M4 to M6 / F4 to F6

• TMF +60: M7 to M9+ / F7 to F9+

Team composition:

• 3 men: -73 kg / -90 kg / +90 kg

• 3 women: -57 kg / -70 kg / +70 kg

4. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN

For French participants:

- ID card or passport
- Sports passport with 2 licenses, including the current season
- Driver's license not accepted

For foreign participants:

- Proof of membership in a recognized federation (EJU / IJF)
- At least 2 years of licenses
- Minimum grade: green belt
- Medical certificate required if not listed in a sports passport

Insurance:

Each competitor must have liability and personal injury coverage.

5. REGISTRATION

Only via the France Judo extranet.

6. AGE CATEGORIES

As defined above: TMF -45 • TMF -60 • TMF +60

7. UNIFORMS

- White or blue judogi, FIJ or FFJDA compliant
- Blue judogi recommended if the entire team wears blue
- FIJ / EJU back patches allowed

8. COMPETITION FORMAT

- Rules: IJF Mixed Teams
- **4–5 teams** \rightarrow single pool
- 6 teams \rightarrow 2 pools of 3 + semifinals
- 7 teams \rightarrow 1 pool of 4 + 1 pool of 3 + semifinals
- More than 7 teams → double repechage bracket
- 1–3 missing athletes → grouping possible by age or weight
- Maximum: 16 teams per age group

9. MATCH DURATION & GOLDEN SCORE

- TMF -45 & TMF -60 \rightarrow 3 minutes
- Unlimited golden score
- **TMF** +**60** \rightarrow 2 min 30
- Decision required after golden score limited to 1 minute
- First score advantage = win
- In case of a 3–3 tie, a random draw among all weight categories decides the Golden Match.

10. GRADE / PARTICIPATION RELATIONSHIP

No link between grade and participation. Allowed from green belt.

11. AWARDS

- Medals for ranked teams
- Trophies for podium teams
