






SOME HISTORY

When it was created in 1971, the Paris Tournament was held at the Stade Pierre de Coubertin and only pitted male fighters in 5 categories against each other: -63kg, -70kg, -80kg, -93kg, +93kg. In 1979, the number of categories changed to 7. Women entered the competition in 1988.

For its 26th edition in 2000, the Paris Tournament moved to the Palais Omnisports de Paris-Bercy, better suited to the popular success of this competition which brings together the world's greatest judokas.

In 2002, it became the Paris Ile-de-France Tournament, and since 2009, it has been the first Grand Slam to be held under the International Judo Federation's new program of meetings. Due to renovation work at the POPB, which prevented any events from being held, the 2015 edition was doubly exceptional in that it was held in October (rather than February) and was the inaugural event for the brand new AccorHotels Arena. This year, the Paris Grand Slam will be held for the 50th time.

HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM

USING PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Metro: Lines 6 and 14, "Bercy" station

Bus: Lines 24 and 87, "Gare de Bercy" station

BY TRAIN

Gare de Lyon and Gare de Paris-Austerlitz are both less than 900 metres from the Accor Arena.

BY CAR

From the centre of Paris => on the right bank, take the lane alongside the Accor Arena.

From the 12th and 13th arrondissements => take boulevard de Bercy.

From the south-east and south-west of Paris => Take the ring road (boulevard périphérique), the Bercy interchange of which is located 1 200 meters from the Accor Arena.



PRESS ROOM

- Open daily from 7:30 to 22:00.
- A buffet breakfast is served as soon as it opens, as well as snacks in the afternoon.
- Equipped with a photocopier and lockers for photographers (padlocks available in exchange for a deposit).
- Internet connection (cable and wifi).
- Screens to follow the fights.




